## RED ROSE CHAPTER AWARD



**Why?** This program is designed to recognize well rounded chapters who contribute to the State Program of Work! They must take part in member development, community service, conferences, leadership activities, national programs, and competitive events.

**How?** In order to be recognized with this award, chapters must complete all of the required elements as well as 20 out of 53 points of the Additional Point Options. The point values are in red next to the description below. An official application form must be filled out to give proof of completion.

**When?** Applications are due on March 1st and chapters will be recognized at the SLC during the Recognition Dinner when their chapter presidents go on stage to receive the award.

### Requirements:



- Maintain or increase your chapter's membership.
- Chapter participation in the virtual Fall Leadership Connection.
- Compete in 2 Fall Competitive Events
- Chapter attendance at Leadership Bootcamp (at least 4 members and 1 adviser)
- Compete in competitive events at the SLC (at least 5 members competing)
- Complete Power of One (at least 2 members)

### Additional Point Options: *(must complete a minimum of 16 points)*

**Points Options** *(Show proof of each item with photos, screenshots, and documents, as applicable)*

- 1 • Submit an application for a State or National award for recognition
- 1 • Chapter participation in FCS Dine in Day, December 3<sup>rd</sup> (Show promotion and proof of participation)
- 2 • Chapter participation in Campaign for Tobacco Free Kids Program
- 2 • Meet with a superintendent or member of your town's school BOE to promote FCS and FCCLA
- 2 • Chapter attendance at the 2020 Virtual NLC (at least 2 members and 1 adviser)
- 2 • Make a chapter social media account and follow NJ FCCLA
- 2 • Create an FCCLA bulletin board at your school
- 3 • Collaborate with another CTSO or business/industry partner
- 3 • Chapter members competed in the 2020 National virtual STAR Events
- 3 • Created and followed through with a chapter service project (your choice)
- 3 • Make a chapter website and email the link to [njfccla@gmail.com](mailto:njfccla@gmail.com)
- 3 • Competing in a STAR event at SLC
- 3 • Participate in 3 of the FCCLA Week initiatives.
- 3 • Attend the Virtual Leadership Experience offered by National FCCLA
- 4 • Complete in a National Program (other than Power of One) and submit the application on [fcclainc.org](http://fcclainc.org)
- 4 • Apply for Go For the Red Membership Campaign ([fcclainc.org](http://fcclainc.org))
- 4 • Provides an article for the New Directions Newsletter or had an article printed in your town newspaper
- 5 • Mentor a new chapter (proof of at least 3 supportive initiatives)
- 5 • Provided an informative workshop for either the virtual FLC for SLC
- 5 • Meet with a member of NJ legislature to advocate for FCCLA and FCS
