



RED ROSE CHAPTER AWARD

Why? This program is designed to recognize well rounded chapters who contribute to the State Program of Work! They must take part in member development, community service, conferences, leadership activities, national programs, and competitive events.

How? In order to be recognized with this award, chapters must complete all of the required elements as well as 20 out of 53 points of the Additional Point Options. The point values are in red next to the description below. An official application form must be filled out to give proof of completion.

When? Applications are due on March 1st and chapters will be recognized at the SLC during the Recognition Dinner when their chapter presidents go on stage to receive the award.

Requirements:



- Increase your chapters membership.
- Chapter participation at the Fall Leadership Connection (8 members)
- Participated in 4 Fall Competitive Events
- Chapter attendance at Leadership Bootcamp (at least 6 members and 1 adviser)
- Participate in the State Leadership Conference (10 members minimum)
- Compete in competitive events at the SLC (at least 5 event entries)
- Complete Power of One (at least 5 members)
- Host two service initiatives
- Print Fall and Winter Newsletter and deliver to school administration

Additional Point Options: (must complete a minimum of 20 points)
